What Is Endoscopy?

Endoscopy is a minimally invasive procedure that uses a small camera to allow physicians to detect cancer, remove precancerous growths, investigate symptoms, and deliver lifesaving care, often in one visit. Procedures including colonoscopy (detects and removes pre-cancerous polyps) and gastroscopy (examines the upper digestive tract) enable earlier detection, faster answers, and effective prevention. Delta deserves timely access to this essential care for patients.



The second leading cause of cancer-related death is colorectal cancer.



3,630 people are diagnosed annually, and 1,300 die from the disease in BC.



90% of cases are preventable or treatable when caught early through screening.

A new Endoscopy Suite will save lives today while building the capacity we need for tomorrow. Now is the time to build a future where prevention is possible, early detection is routine, and physicians choose Delta as a place to grow.



The Endoscopy Suite will include:

- 1 fully equipped procedure room with state-of-the-art endoscopy technology and digital imaging
- 3 private recovery bays
- 2 pre-procedure beds
- A dedicated reprocessing and sterilization area to ensure the highest infection-control standards
- Ceiling lifts and ergonomic layouts to prevent staff injuries and support safe patient transfers
- Improved patient flow to reduce bottlenecks and cancellations
- Space for training, teaching and collaboration among physicians and care teams
